- Each scholarship will be in the amount of \$400
- Scholarships are intended for CE volunteers, Christian Educators or pastors serving in New Covenant Presbytery who have little or no continuing education funds
- Up to nine scholarships will be awarded through the generosity of a New Covenant Vision Initiative Grant
- Deadline for application submission is October 15, 2008.
- Notification of award will be sent to recipients by November 4, 2008.
- Scholarship funds will be transmitted to recipients only upon verification of actual registration for the 2009 APCE Annual Event.
- Recipients will be asked to submit a brief summary of their APCE event experience after the conclusion of the 2009 event.
- If for any reason recipients find themselves unable to attend the Annual Event, the scholarship funds must be returned to the Presbytery of New Covenant immediately.
- All applications will be reviewed and decided upon by a committee of the congregational Resourcing Team, Presbytery of New Covenant.
