THE TRUE STORY OF THE THREE LITTLE PIGS by A. Wolf as told to Jon Sciescka

Wait! The wolf has a thing to say - he's been framed all these years and now he wants you to know the truth!

THE THREE HORRID LITTLE PIGS by Liz Pichon - what happens when the three little pigs are so horrid they even drive their own mother crazy and she sends them packing

THE THREE CABRITOS by Eric Kimmel - an original retelling with a Texas twist

ZIGGY PIGGY AND THE THREE LITTLE PIGS by Frank Asch - Ziggy is the lazy brother - he just wants to have fun and relax

THE THREE LITTLE PIGS AND THE BIG BAD PIG by C. Voake - this is fun to read aloud but it is a little unnerving for some taste - read first and then determine if you want to read aloud

BUBBA, THE COWBOY PRINCE by Helen Ketteman - put on your Texas drawl and read this with gusto - find a good voice for the fairy god cow!

DINORELLA:A PREHISTORIC FAIRY TALE by Pamela Edwards - can be used in your fairy tale unit or dinosaur unit

DUSTY LOCKS AND THE THREE BEARS by Tony Johnston - This retelling finds "Goldilocks" being a little rowdy and pure country

GOLDIE SOCKS AND THE THREE LIBEARIANS by Jackie Hopkins - Goldie finds the "just right" books with help from the libearians

A CHAIR FOR BABY BEAR by Kaye Umansky - since Goldilocks broke Little Bear's chair , he must go and find another "just right" chair

SOMEBODY AND THE THREE BLAIRS by Marilyn Tolhurst - Mr. and Mrs. Blair and Baby Blair decide to go for a walk in the park and while they are gone Somebody comes to the door and finds it open. So cute!

THE THREE SNOW BEARS by Jan Brett- retelling of Goldilocks set in an Eskimo village

GOLDSILLOCKS RETURNS by Lisa Ernst - after years of guilt, Goldi returns to make amends

THE COWBOY AND THE BLACK-EYE PEA by Tony Johnston - the wealthy daughter of a rancher devises a plan to find a REAL cowboy among her many suitors

LITTLE RED COWBOY HAT by Susan Lowell - a western retelling of Little Red Riding Hood

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD: AND THE WOLF'S TALE by Della Rowland - this is an Upside Down Tale - you read the original and then turn the book and read an updated version

LITTLE RED RIDING HOOD: A NEW FANGLED PRAIRIE TALE by L. Ernst - in this retelling Grandma drives a tractor and doesn't much like pesky predators

ARMADILLY CHILI by Helen Ketteman - just like The Little Red Hen, Armadilly Chili can find no one to help with making her chilli

LITTLE RED HEN: MAKES A PIZZA by Amy Walrod - same story with a different outcome - PIZZA! Kids love this retelling!

LITTLE RED HEN GETS HELP by K. Spengler - after cooking tacos the LRH asks for help cleaning up but no one wants to help (sound familiar?)

THE JALAPENO MAN by Debbie Leland - you guessed it - a hotter version of The Gingerbread Man

THE GINGERBREAD GIRL by L. Ernst - this smart girl will not make the same mistakes as the Gingerbread Boy!

THE GINGERBREAD COWBOY by Janet Squires - a Texas cowboy version - read before sharing to determine if you want to alter the ending!

THE FROG PRINCIPAL by Stephanie Calmenson - Mr. Bundy, the school principal, is accidentally turned into a frog during a school magic show and the magician can't recall how to restore him

THE DINOSAUR'S NEW CLOTHES by Diane Goode - lavish illustrations by the master, Diane Goode

MIDAS MOUSE by David Ellwand - Midas makes a wish that everything he touches with his four pink paws would suddenly turn to shiny gold like the sunshine

THE JOLLY POSTMAN by A. Ahlberg - interactive tale about a postman delivering letters to well known fairy tale characters
